
Extract from resolutions of the meeting held on 10/01/2019



Details: On 15th January 2019, Anti-ragging advisory committee of Hiralal Bhakat College organized an Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme in an effort to promote a safe and welcoming environment for all students on the campus. The programme aimed at

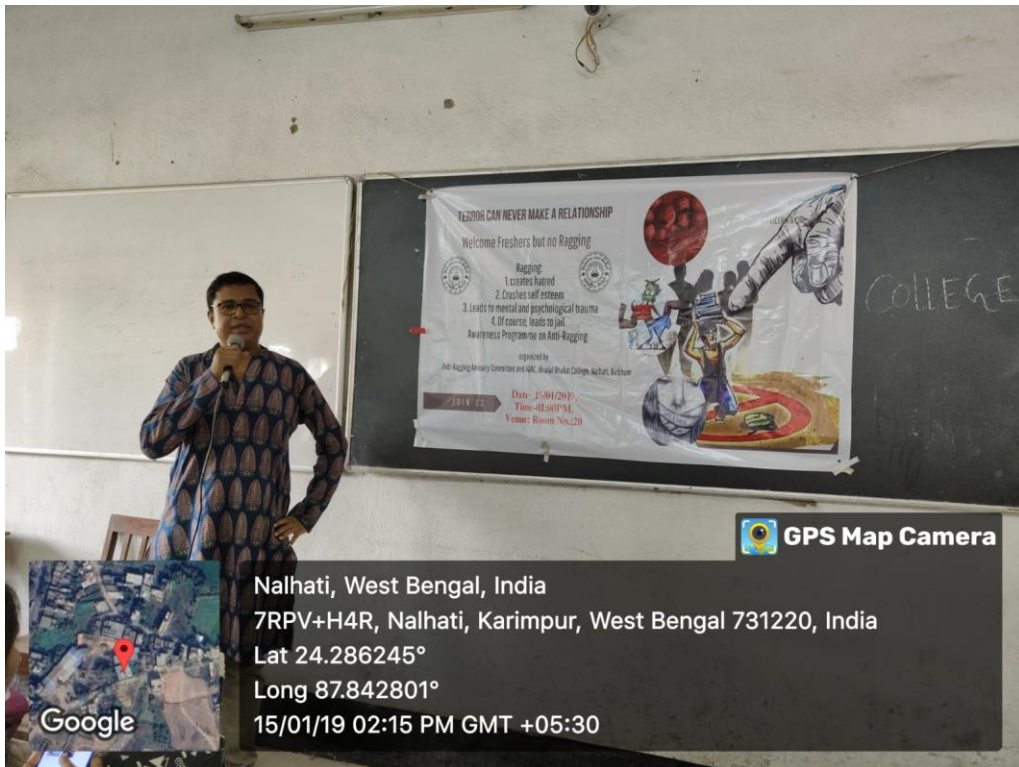
educating students about the harmful effects of ragging and to raise awareness about the consequences of engaging in such activities. The event began with an opening speech by our Honourable TIC, Prof. Debabrata Saha, HOD, Department of Philosophy, highlighting the college's zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and emphasizing the importance of creating a conducive learning environment for all students. This was followed by a series of informative presentations and interactive sessions conducted by the college faculty and guest speakers, who shared insights on the legal aspects of ragging, the psychological impact on victims, and the role of students in preventing ragging incidents. The attendees enthusiastically participated in talks, giving their viewpoints and promising to uphold dignity and compassion in their dealings with other pupils.

Besides, the college distributed informational pamphlets and posters on anti-ragging measures, encouraging students to report any incidents of ragging to the college authorities promptly. The students selected as a representative of Anti-ragging from each and every department were, then, announced to have come on the stage to get introduced. The event concluded with a pledge-taking ceremony, where students vowed to stand against ragging and to promote a harmonious and inclusive campus environment.

Outcome: Students as well as faculty members present at the programme got enriched with the worthy words and information delivered at the different guests' speech. The Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme at Hiralal Bhakat College was a huge step towards instilling a culture of respect, empathy, and mutual understanding among students. By increasing awareness and teaching students about the negative impacts of ragging, the curriculum demonstrated the college's commitment to the well-being and safety of all members of the academic community. 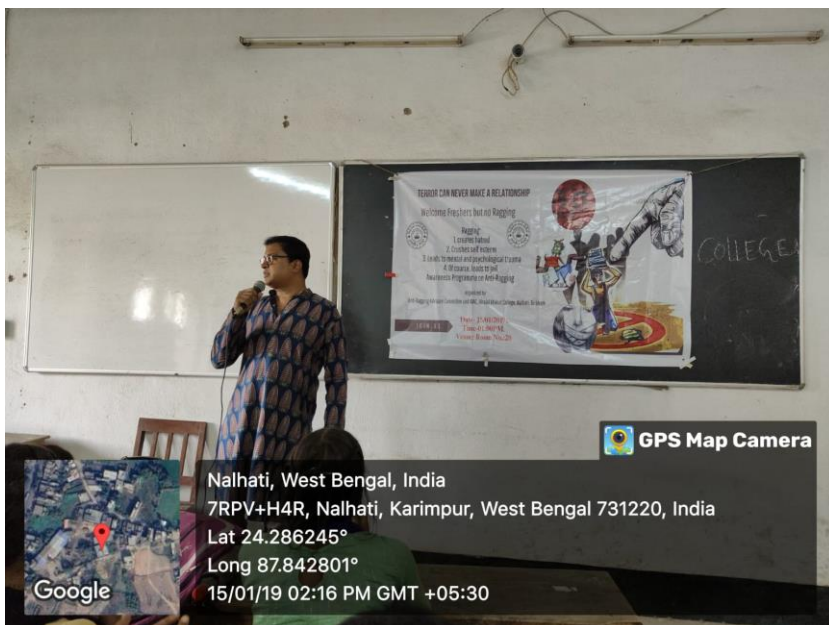

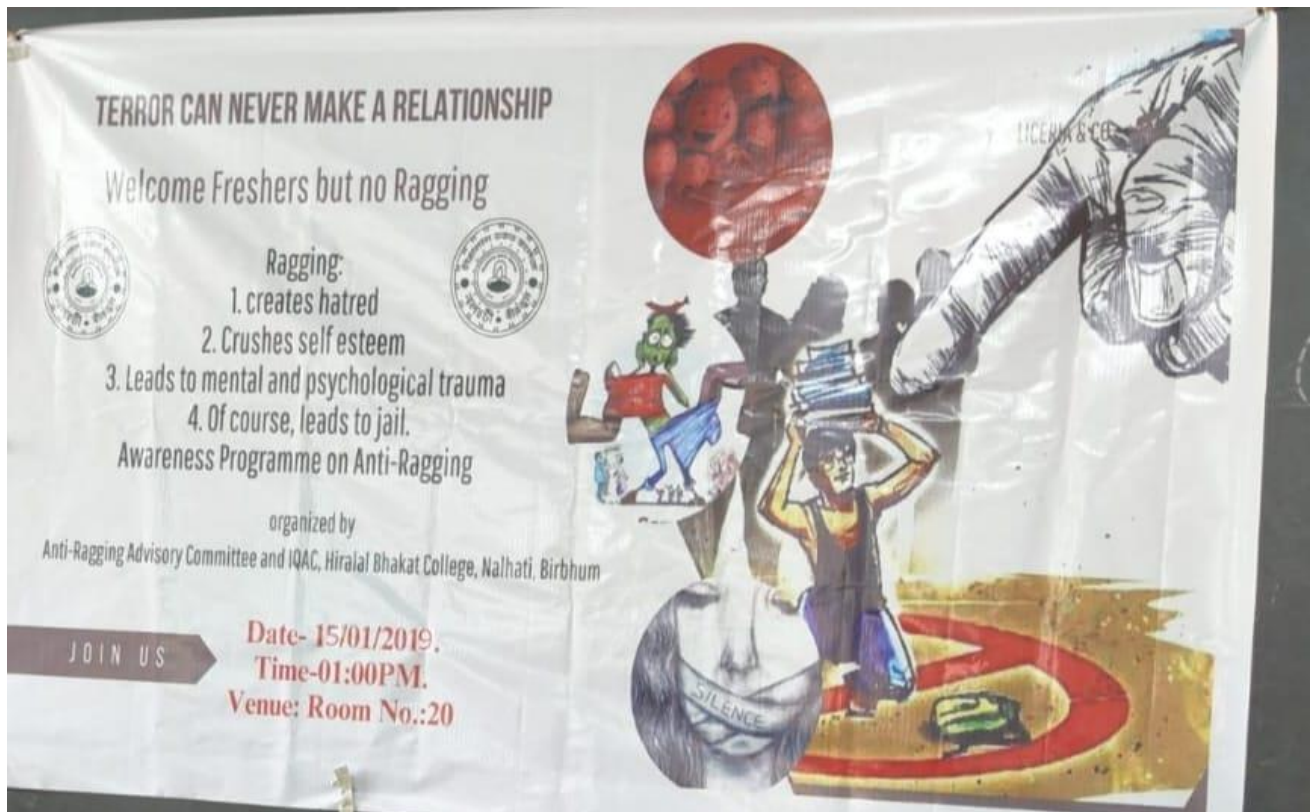
