





Details:

The observation of **International Mother Language Day** was successfully organised by the Cultural advisory committee of Hiralal Bhakat College on 21/02/2019 at 12:00 noon in the room no-20. The programme was all about the importance of 'Bangla bhasha' as our mother tongue. The programme was started with the auspicious event of lightening of lamp and offering of flowers at the altar of Sahid minar.
