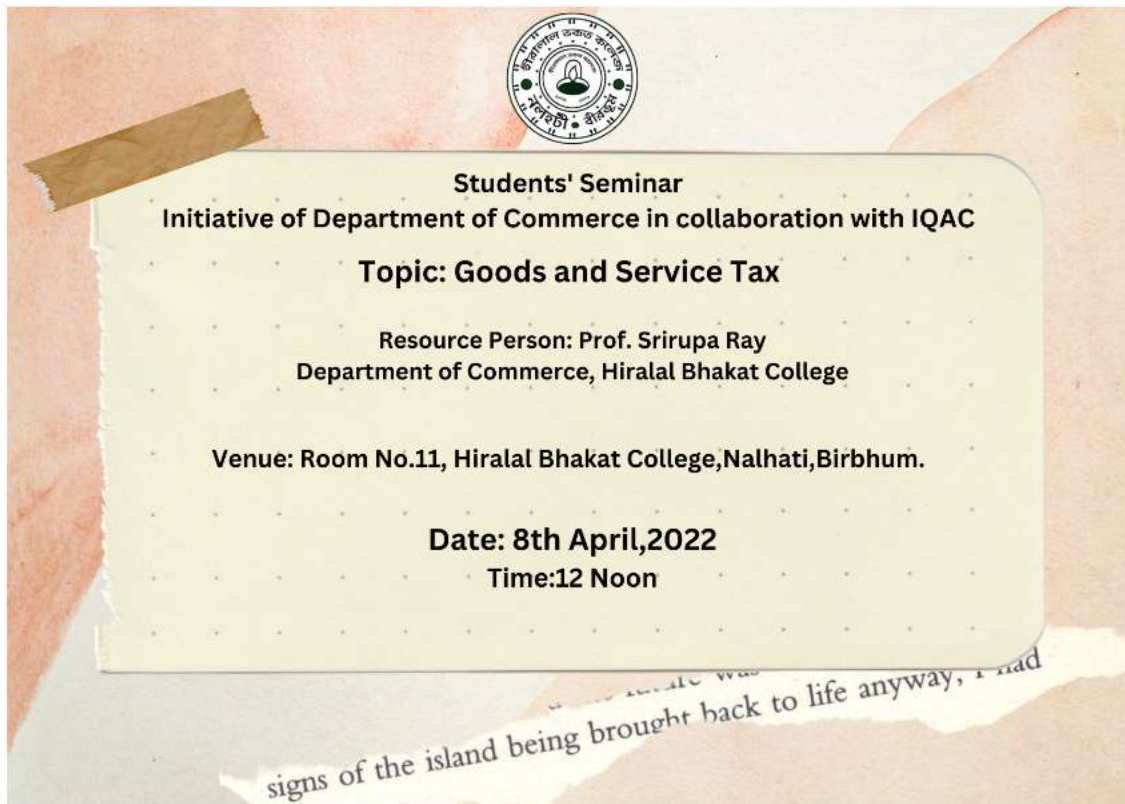

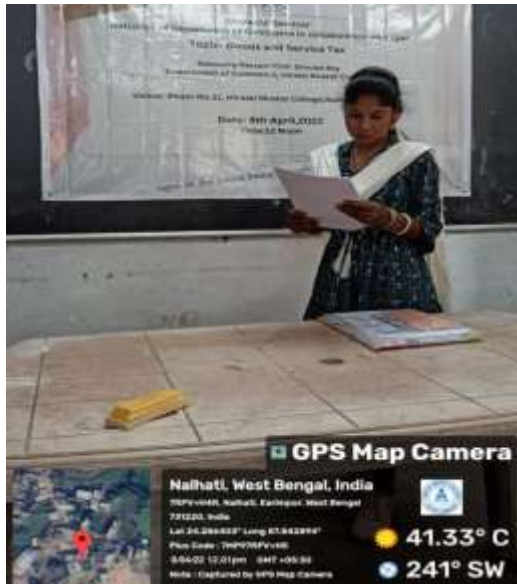
Outcome
